Each week we will be taking a trip as a part of our summer fun program. Check the calendar and sign up to help transport children to a different destination each week.

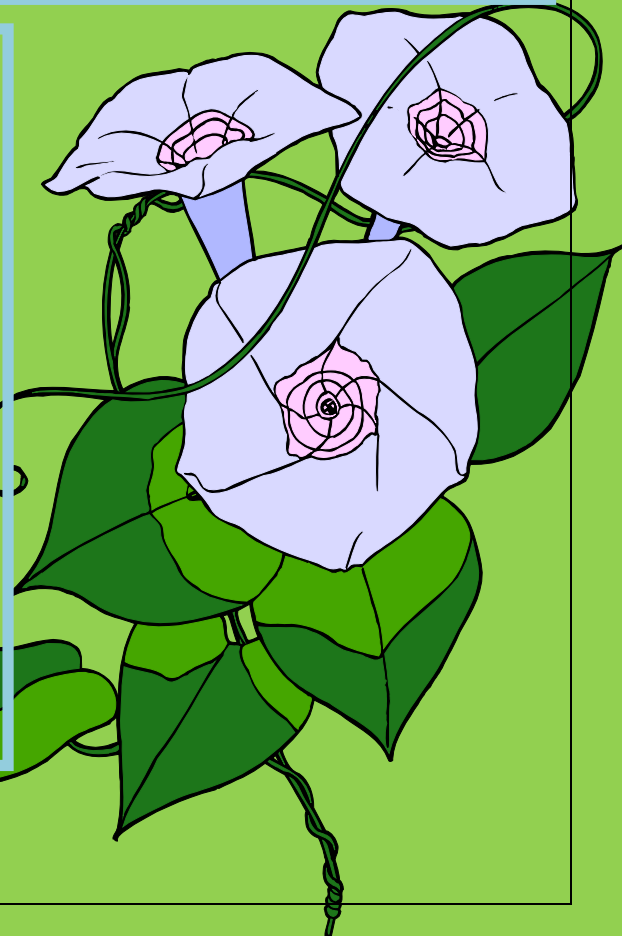
Summer Program Helpers

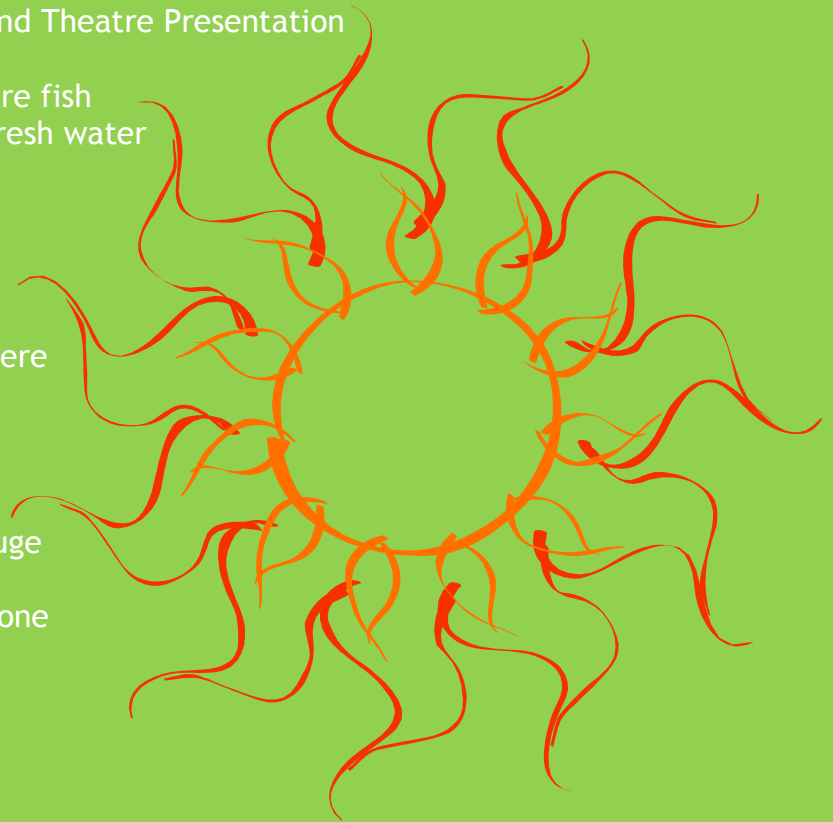
